

Then she will provide you with the basic knowledge needed to develop a successful application for European research funding under Horizon Europe, the current seven-year framework programme for research funding of the European Union.

Mr. Bastian Raue from the Nationale Kontaktstelle Recht und Finanzen will provide you with the general conditions regarding collaborations with non-European countries like those in Sub-Sahara Africa.

Dr. Christina Möckel from the Nationale Kontaktstelle Digitale und Industrielle Technologien (NKS DIT) will provide you with an overview of the aims and content of the cluster "Digital, Industry and Space" (Cluster 4) and on current and future calls specifically open to collaboration with Africa.

Mr. Martino Piani from the Nationale Kontaktstelle Klima, Enelcrlgie, Mobilität (NKS KEM) will provide you with an overview of the aims and content of Cluster 5 "Climate, Energy and Mobility" and on current and future calls specifically open to collaboration with Africa.

Dr. Frank Dreger from the Nationale Kontaktstelle Lebensmittel, Bioökonomie, natürliche Ressourcen, Landwirtschaft und Umwelt (NKS Bioökonomie und Umwelt) will provide you with an overview of the aims and content of this Cluster 6 "Food, Bioeconomy, Natural Resources, Agriculture and Environment" and on current and future calls specifically open to collaboration with Africa.

Ms Katalin Alföldi will close the training with insight into how COST – the association for European Cooperation in Science and Technology – supports collaboration in Networks and "COST actions" (tbc).
